Steven E. Kahn, MB, ChB is a Professor of Medicine in the Division of Metabolism, Endocrinology and Nutrition at the VA Puget Sound Health Care System and University of Washington in Seattle. Additionally, he is Associate Director of the Diabetes Endocrinology Research Centre at the University of Washington.

Dr. Kahn's research interests include β -cell function in normal subjects and the pathogenesis of hyperglycemia in patients with type 2 diabetes. He has also done extensive work on the role of islet amyloid in the pathogenesis of the islet lesion in type 2 diabetes.

Among his awards are the Herman Ostrum Memorial Award, the Dana Foundation Feasibility Award, the Novartis Award in Diabetes, the American Diabetes Association Distinguished Clinical Scientist Award, and the R.H. Williams–Rachmiel Levine Award. He has been elected to membership in the American Society for Clinical Investigation and the American Association of Physicians.
